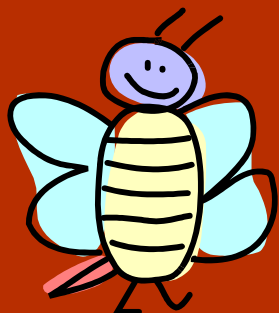

Flu Season is Here

“The single best way to protect against the flu is to get vaccinated each year” - James McCurtis, Michigan Dept. of Community Health.

MDCH recommends a seasonal flu vaccine for everyone 6 months of age and older, new parents, healthcare providers and anyone who cares for people age 65 or older.

The 2010 flu vaccine will protect against 3 different flu viruses: the H3N2 virus, an influenza B virus and the H1N1 virus.

Flu season can start as early as October and run through May. It takes about a week for the vaccine to start protecting you from the flu, so now is the time to get your flu shot.

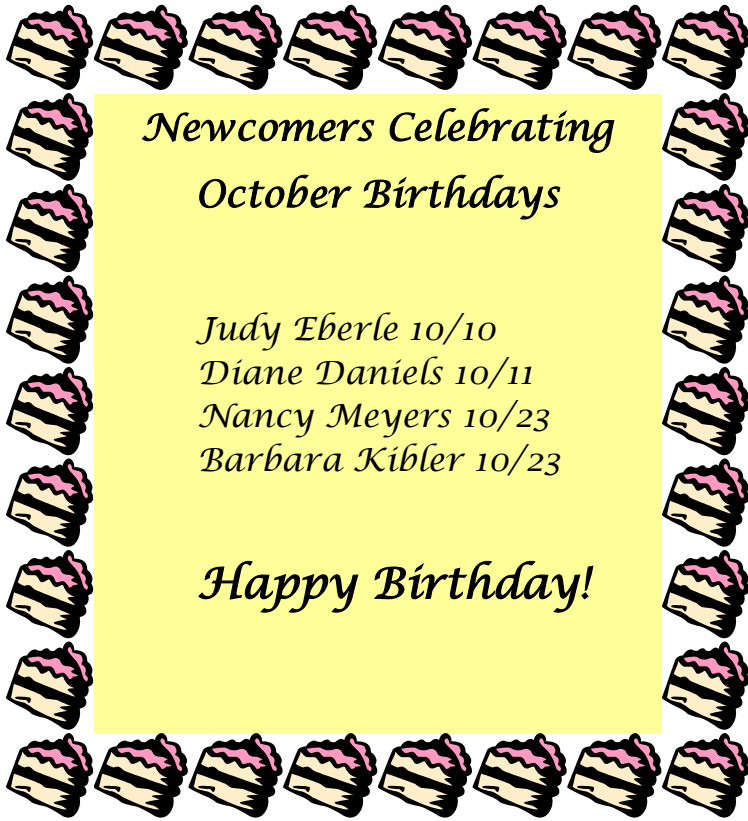

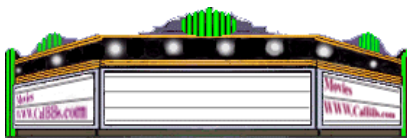
